

If our Character doesn't match our Christ then it really isn't Christianity because to be a Christian means to be 'like Christ.'


There are THREE primary ways to
ADVANCE God's Kingdom:

1) Worship – John 4:23

2) Witness – Luke 19:10

3) Warfare – Ezekiel 22:30

Eph. 2:6 ...and raised us up with Him, and
seated us with Him in the heavenly *places*
in Christ Jesus,



Eph. 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called.

Eph. 6:11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

The life of the believer always involves
ALL THREE OF THESE – our position in
Christ, our life in this world, and our
warfare.

Our Position 'In Christ'

Eph. 1:17-21 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ,...raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly *places*, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.

Eph. 2:6-9 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus,...For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Christian life does not begin with walking;
it begins with sitting.

Colossians 3:3 For you died, and your life
is hidden **with Christ**, in God.

Christianity begins not with a big DO, but with a big DONE.

Eph. 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

Heb. 4:9-11 So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God. For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. Therefore let us be diligent (strive or make every effort) to enter that rest, so that no one will fall, through *following* the same example of disobedience.

To 'sit' in Christ means we rest our future,
our load, ourselves, our finances, our
jobs, our security ON HIM!

Acts 17:28 for 'in Him' we **live** and **move**
and exist (have our being)...

When we live, remain, dwell, stay in that
place; when we think and respond from a
life 'in Him' then things change.

Rom 8:1 there is now no condemnation
for those who are 'in Christ Jesus',

2 Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks be unto
God, which always causeth us to triumph
'in Christ',

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that 'in him' we might become the righteousness of God.

Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us 'in him' before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

Colossians 1:28 that we may present **every man perfect** 'in Christ Jesus':

Col 2:10 And **ye are complete** 'in him', which is the head of all principality and power:
